

Information about The Alchemical Theatre Laboratory

I will go to the The Alchemical Theatre Laboratory to see Arch Contemporary Ballet.

The Alchemical Theatre is located at 104 W 14th Street,
Between Sixth and Seventh Avenues.



Doors will open at 1:30 pm on the day of the performance. I will go through the door and find the stair way down the hallway. I may have to stand in line. If I stand in line I will stay with [inset name/s] and try to be quiet.



I will go up the stairs to the theatre door on the 2nd floor, the stair case is grey and white.

If I feel afraid, I can hold [insert name/s] hand, squeeze a fidget or take five deep breaths.




At the top of the stairs someone will tell us where to go.

I can use the bathroom before I go into the theatre. To get there I will go up the stairs to the 3rd floor.




I will follow the gray carpet down the hallway to the bathroom. The bathroom has a fun black and white floor.

If I feel afraid, I can hold [insert name/s] hand, squeeze a fidget or take five deep breaths.




Inside the Theatre

The Usher will give us a Program. A Program is a book. I can look at the Program with [insert name/s].




DURING THE SHOW
